

What is Junk in the Trunk?

- Is a great social event --sponsored by Watseka Area Chamber of Commerce and the City of Watseka
- Helps folks clean out unwanted items & downsize
- Gives people who can't have a garage sale an opportunity to do so
- Is a great place to find something special
- Is economical - all located together in small venues
- Is like going to many garage sales in one spot

Guidelines:

- 4th Saturday (weather permitting) from July to September (in 2017)
- Operating hours: 9am – 2pm. Set up time is approximately 8:30 am the day of event.
- Set up must be in designated areas (you cannot set up anywhere on city streets) Police will ask you to leave.
- Registration prior to the event is required by Friday of the event week.
- Arrivals the day of the event without registration will not be guaranteed a spot.
- Spots will be lined up upon arrival - no saving of spaces
- Location: Route 24 in Kay Park (Across from Dollar General Store) Other locations will be added if the size of the event requires it
- You will be directed where to park when you arrive.
- A spot is approximately 10' x 15+ deep. This space will fit your vehicle or 10 x10 tent. You bring your own tables/everything.
- No commercial vendors, mass-produced/bulk, imported items or imported clothes are allowed. No guns or firearms for sale. This doesn't mean Tupperware/Thirty-one and such. No siding companies and no mass flea market from China stuff.
- Antiques, crafts, artwork, household items, tools, collectibles, garage/estate sale items are encouraged.
- All participants are responsible for their own cleanup. NO boxes, garbage, or unsold items can be left at the site.
- All participants are at their own risk & are responsible for accidents.
- Rain, extreme heat, threatening weather will cancel this event. - an email will be sent to vendors by 7 am
- Remember to visit/support local businesses that support this event.
- Do not block traffic or impede access to any businesses. Be courteous
- Consider umbrellas, rain gear, tarps, etc. for convenience. Using weights to hold things down if/or when the wind picks up.
